All books must be for sale. The gallery will receive a commission of 20% when works are sold.

Artists are requested to submit 1 book or in the case of miniatures, up to 3 books.

Size limitation: Books have to be smaller than 30 × 40 cm (11" x 16") and less than 5 cm thick.

Participation fee for selected artists: 3.500 Japanese Yen / 40 Euro / 50 Dollars

The artist pays the shipping to Japan, and the organizers cover the return postage.

Application requirements: 1 image of the cover, 2 images of inside pages.

When sending your images as email attachments, <u>be sure that they are reduced to small size</u>: images should not exceed 640 x 480 pixels, 72 dpi. Total size limit for 3 images is 2 MB.

Application period: January 7 - March 20, 2011

Notification of acceptance by email: the middle of April, 2011

Deadline for receiving the actual work: May 20, 2011
